Children are a Heritage from the Lord

Psalm 4:3 "But know that the LORD has set apart for Himself him who is godly; The LORD will hear when I call to Him."

Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope."

I confess that God has a plan for my children that will bring only joy and hope. My children will find, follow, and flow in the perfect will of God. Only God's best will touch my children. God's divine plan will be accomplished for my children.

Psalms 37:23 "The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, and He delights in his way."

I confess that the steps of my children are ordered by the Lord. Each and every day, my children will walk in the footsteps that Jesus Christ wants them to walk in.

Luke 2:52 "And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men."

I confess that my children are growing in wisdom and favor with God and man. My children are developing in social skills. My children are growing in daily judgment. My children are clothed with favor from upon high.

Isaiah 10:27 "It shall come to pass in that day that his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, and his yoke from your neck, and the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil."

I confess that my children walk in and under the anointing of God. God's presence is always upon my children. Angels of God are always near my children. The power of God is daily and continually flowing in and through my children's lives.
