



SERVICE TIPS

- Technical needs
 - o DVD player
 - o TV or video projector
 - o Sound system
 - o Tech person
- Length of service
 - o Superkid Academy is adaptable to any service time because it's a combination of short video segments with lessons and activities led by your team.
 - o When planning your service, it's easy to adjust the length of time you spend on games, lessons and all the other elements.
 - o We suggest you run through the material and create your own schedule that fits the time you have available.
- How the DVD "works"
 - o From start to finish, the DVD will create each element of the service, with seamless transitions to the video elements. The DVD is designed to "guide" the flow of the service, or be used as support where desired.
 - o OR you can pick and choose which elements you want to use.
 - o Simply select the lesson you want on the DVD, and "start" the service with the five-minute count-down video.
 - o At the end of each DVD segment, simply advance to the next segment, using your Lesson Book to teach and lead activities.
- Before service
 - o Prepare the room and test equipment.
 - o Make sure you have all your props and supplies.
 - o Gather the team for a brief service review.
 - o Pray.

Let's look at each element in the service flow...

- Countdown Video
 - o This five-minute segment sets the stage for the service, and begins to rally the kids
- Welcome and Prayer
 - o Welcome Superkids and visitors
 - o Prayer
- Opening Video Transmission
 - o This is a short video transmission from headquarters that introduces the lesson for the day in about one minute.
- Memory Verse
 - o Each lesson has many scriptures, but one verse is featured as the Memory Verse.
 - o Find creative ways to work with the kids on the Memory Verse.
 - o Have them repeat it.
 - o Have your older kids come up with fun ways to lead it.
- Game Time
 - o Youth volunteers make the best game leaders!
- Supplement 1—This segment varies from week to week to add variety to the service.
 - o Plan smooth transitions—avoid downtime.
 - o Dramas
 - o Object Lessons
 - o Academy Kitchens
 - o Academy Labs
 - o Real Deal Stories, Storybook Theaters and You-Solve-It Mysteries
- Offering
 - o Each week we have an Offering lesson and scripture.
- Praise and Worship Available Separately
 - o Superkid Praise and Worship CDs come with sing-along music tracks.
 - o Superkid Praise and Worship DVD comes with 24 songs with lyric videos, sing-along tracks (and click-tracks for band use).
- Lesson Video Transmission
 - o This is the second video transmission that shows by example, the lesson of the day. It's about three or four minutes long.
 - o After the transmission ends, your cadets will be ready to hear the Word taught.

- Word Time
 - o Preparation is very important.
 - o Prepare with the lesson outline, but allow the Holy Spirit to lead you.
 - o The Teacher Preparation CD is a big help.
 - o Use your own personal stories to illustrate your message.
- Supplement 2—This segment varies from week to week to add variety to the service. The various elements are: Dramas, Object Lessons, Academy Kitchen, Academy Labs, Real Deals, You-Solve-It Mysteries and Storybook Theaters.
- Closing Video Transmission
 - o This is a short video transmission that wraps up the lesson for the day in about one minute.
 - o If there is time, you may want to talk with the Superkids about what they learned from the video transmissions, segments and teachings and ask questions, etc.
- Remember
 - o This is a time for your cadets to reaffirm what they have learned and make a decision to be a doer of the Word.
- Prayer, Announcements, Handouts
 - o You may choose to print out “Handout Sheets” from the CD-ROM, Lesson Book or from superkidacademy.com. These have the memory verse and other great reminders about the topic, for kids to share with their parents.
- Game Reprise
 - o If time allows
